## P u r p o s e o f O u r S c h o o l

The Tohoku University Graduate School of Medicine aims to nurture world-class outstanding researchers and professionals with a high level of specialized knowledge and skills in the field of medicine, a strong spirit of inquiry, a strong sense of mission and ethics, and the ability to specifically promote solutions to problems in the medical field in an advanced, interdisciplinary, and creative manner.

Specifically, we seek students who aspire to become researchers, advanced professionals, or educators possessing rich humanity that contribute to new developments in the medical field with the aim of improving the health and welfare of people in Japan and around the world through specialized knowledge and skills supported by a strong spirit of inquiry and a strong sense of mission and ethics.

For this reason, we conduct entrance examinations through general admission, special admission for working adults (only for the PhD Degree Program (4-year course)), Examination for Admission for Overseas Residents and the PhD Degree Program (3-year course)) and special admission (only for some courses in the Master's Degree Program of School of Public Health), and select students based on whether or not they have the high ability and qualities necessary for conducting research in accordance with these educational principles and goals.

## Admissions Policy

### Disability Sciences

In the general selection examination and Examination for Admission for Overseas Residents, we select students based on English proficiency evaluated using applicants' scores on external examinations and oral examinations evaluating their specialized knowledge, thinking ability, motivation, and aptitude, with special emphasis on those who aim to become researchers, advanced specialists, or educators who will contribute to academic research and social practice in the field of disability science and rehabilitation-related fields. English proficiency equivalent to that of a graduate of a six-year university or master's degree course, basic advanced-specialized knowledge and thinking ability in relation to the applicant's major and field of study, specific motivation, and aptitude for study are necessary to exceed the criteria set by the Graduate School, and the results of the oral examination are especially important in the selection process. Note that students are expected to have acquired basic advanced-specialized knowledge and English language skills prior to admission.

### Health Sciences

In the general selection examination and Examination for Admission for Overseas Residents, we select students based on English proficiency evaluated using

applicants' scores on external examinations and oral examinations evaluating their specialized knowledge, thinking ability, motivation, and aptitude, with special emphasis on those who aim to become researchers or educators who will contribute to the international community and have the ability to conduct research activities related to nursing or radiological/medical technology sciences independently. English proficiency equivalent to that of a graduate of a six-year university or master's degree course, basic advanced-specialized knowledge and thinking ability in relation to the applicant's major and field of study, specific motivation, and aptitude for study are necessary to exceed the criteria set by the Graduate School, and the results of the oral examination are especially important in the selection process.

Note that students are expected to have acquired basic advanced-specialized knowledge and English language skills prior to admission.

Tohoku University Graduate School of Medicine is seeking students for the Examination for Admission for Overseas Resident Doctoral Program [Major of DISABILITY SCIENCES] according to the following guidelines:

## 2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- (1) Applicants must satisfy one of the following requirements by the day prior to the day of desired enrollment and must live outside Japan at the time of application. Eligible applicants are Those who have a master's degree or a professional degree (or expected to receive it by Mar 2027)
- (2) Those who have been conferred a degree equivalent to the master's degree or a professional degree at a graduate school of a foreign university (or expect to receive it by Mar 2027).
- (3) Those who have obtained, or are expected to obtain by Mar 2027, a degree equivalent to a master's degree or professional degree after completing correspondence courses provided in Japan by a foreign school of said country.
- (4) Those who have obtained, or are expected to obtain by Mar 2027, a master's degree or professional degree from foreign educational institutions in Japan offering graduate courses that conform with the educational system of the relevant country and separately designated by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT).
- (5) Those who have obtained, or are expected to obtain by Mar 2027, a master's degree through course completion at the United Nations University as prescribed in Article 1, Paragraph 2 of the Act on Special Measures incidental to Enforcement of the Agreement between the United Nations and Japan regarding the Headquarters of the United Nations University (Act No. 72 of 1976), which was established under the December 11, 1972, resolution of the General Assembly of the United Nations (hereafter referred to as "United Nations University")
- (6) Those who have completed an education course at a foreign school or those who have attended the United Nations University and have passed an examination or a screening equivalent to the regulations of Article 16.2 of the Standards for the Establishment of Graduate Schools (Ordinance of the Ministry of Education, No.

28 of 1973) and are recognized to have academic qualifications equivalent to holders of a master's degree from this graduate school or who will obtain the same by Mar 2027.

- (7) Those who are specified by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (Ordinance of the Ministry of Education No. 118 of 1989)
- (8) Those who have undergone a special admissions screening and are recognized by the Tohoku University Graduate School of Medicine as having achieved an academic level equivalent to those who have a master's or professional degree, and are 24 years of age or older by Mar 2027.

**(EXPLANATORY REMARKS)**

1. Please make sure you fully understand the research content of the department you wish to apply for and contact the professor of the department directly before applying to obtain his/her approval for your application.

2. In the case of a foreigner, please confirm the entrance qualification to the Graduate Academic Affairs Section, Graduate School of Medicine before submitting the application form.

3. The "Master's Degree or Professional Degree" listed in item (1), (2), (3), (4), and (8) of the Qualifications for Application refers to degrees conferred by a graduate school in Japan.

4. Applicants who satisfy the conditions for item (7), must contact the Graduate Academic Affairs Section before applying.

5. Applicants who satisfy the conditions for item (8), must pass the preliminary screening for admissions.

### 3. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

#### (1) ONLINE APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applicants are required to complete the application procedures by the online application system, The Admissions Office (hereinafter referred to as TAO), within the application period. The outline is as follows.

#### 1 Confirmation of application guidelines and obtaining necessary documents

- Please ask your university or college to issue certificates of graduation (or expected graduation), transcripts and other documents for your application in advance.
- Note: Application cannot be accepted without a prior approval from a prospective supervisor.

#### 2 Payment of examination fee



- **For those who live overseas, the application fee is required to pay by credit card.** Please contact the Graduate Academic Affairs Section before applying.

**[NOTE] Application registration or payment of the application fee is not enough to complete the application procedure.**

#### 3 Apply on the TAO application website

- Uploading of certificates and other documents is also available at the TAO.
- Once you have registered, **you cannot make any changes to your registration.** When registering, please do so carefully and make sure that there are no errors.

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#### (5) IMPORTANT REMINDER

- ① Any blank spaces or irregularities found in applications may result in rejection of the application so applicants should exercise great care when filling out the application form.
- ② If false declarations are made in the application documents or if the original documents cannot be verified at the time of enrollment procedures, it may result in cancellation of admission if the applicant is initially accepted.
- ③ If an applicant has committed serious misconduct before enrollment, the school may cancel acceptance or revoke admission even after the applicant has been enrolled.
- ④ The application fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.
- ⑤ Applicants who have satisfied the conditions for entry through preliminary screening should convert the acceptance notification to PDF or image data and upload it by TAO.
- ⑥ The University does not accept the application withdrawal after the reception and the modification of contents of applications.

## 4. SCREENING

(1) Applicants will be evaluated based on the following perspectives

① The official score certificate of the English proficiency test (TOEIC®, TOEFL®, IELTS etc.) official score certificate

② Oral examination score

In the oral examination, the applicant's professional knowledge, ability to think, motivation for application, and aptitude will be evaluated.

(3) EVALUATION OF FOREIGN LANGUAGE (ENGLISH)

The score of TOEIC®, TOEFL®, IELTS etc. submitted at the application is converted into the normal score. If several score records are provided, the highest record is used for evaluation.

(4) Applicants of the Health Sciences major who meet (7) or (8) of the eligibility requirements and have a certain amount of work experience in medical, health, welfare facilities, educational or research institutions, government offices or companies (as shown in the table below) will be considered in the selection process. The oral examination will be the same as that for general applicants.

Educational Background	Amount of work experience
(A) Those who graduated from a “Tanki Daigaku 短期大学”, Junior college in Japan, with 2 years of study.	4 years or more
(B) Those who graduated from a “Tanki Daigaku 短期大学”, Junior college in Japan, with 3 years of study.	3 years or more
(C) Those who graduated from a “Koutou Senmongakkou 高等専門学校”, Technical college in Japan with 2 Years of study or more.	4 years or more
(D) Those who graduated from a Postsecondary Course of Specialized Training College in Japan	More than the period deducting the period of graduation from a special training college from the minimum period of study to complete a master's degree (18 years).

(E) Those who graduated from a foreign school, a Japanese school of a foreign country, a special training school (excluding specialized training courses), and other School or educational facility in Japan or abroad.	More than the period deducting the period of graduation from a latest school/educational facility from the minimum period of study to complete a master's degree (18 years). In the case of multiple graduates from schools of the same grade, only the one with the longest term of study will be adopted.
(F) Those who have withdrawn from schools listed in (A) through (E) above.	More than the period deducting the number of years of study up to the time of withdrawal from the school from the minimum period of study to complete a master's degree (18 years). The number of years of study will be determined based on the number of credits earned before withdrawing the school/ institution.

## 5. ANNOUNCEMENT OF SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS &PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

- (1) The identification numbers of the successful applicants will be published on the website around 10:00 am on Sep 3 (Thu), 2026. The results of examination will be noticed at the TAO as well. We cannot answer the examination result on the phone or via email.
- (2) Instructions regarding enrollment will be announced to successful applicants around early Mar 2027. Original of transcripts, graduation certificates, etc. must be submitted at the time of admission procedure.
- (3) Fees for admission are as follows:
  - ① Admission Fees: ¥282,000 (expected amount)
  - ② First Semester Tuition: ¥267,900 (Annual Tuition: ¥535,800) (expected amount)
 (Explanatory Remarks)
  1. The amounts mentioned above may change if fees are revised at school entry or during the period of the applicant's enrollment, in which case the new amount is effective at the time of change.
  2. Information on exemptions for admission or tuition fees or deferment of fees will be included in the admission procedure document packet that is sent after the announcement of successful applicants.
  3. Those who are expected to complete a master's course or a professional degree course of Tohoku University in March 2027 are not required.
- (4) Applicants who are employed at the time of admission must submit a letter of consent from their supervisor.
- (5) In order for international students to obtain "Study" visa and stay in Japan, they

must submit an application for Certificate of Eligibility (COE) to the Sendai Immigration Bureau. The examination period at the Immigration Bureau usually takes one to three months, so please proceed with the procedures as soon as you receive the "Acceptance Letter"

(6) The date of registration for admission is April 1, 2027.

## 6. OTHER INFORMATION

(1) Previous entrance exams can be viewed in front of our office. Please note that only one exam of the previous year is available, and the contents of the exam cannot be taken out or copied. For those who live far away, we also send the previous exam by e-mail. If you have any questions, please contact us at the address below, indicating the major and course you wish to view.

(2) Handling of personal information

1) Personal information held by the University will be handled in compliance with the "Act on the Protection of Personal Information.(Law No. 57 of 2003)" and other laws and regulations, as well as in accordance with the relevant regulations of Tohoku University, such as "Regulations on Protection of Personal Information at National University Corporation Tohoku University" to ensure the protection of personal information.

2) Personal information, such as examination results used for the selection of applicants, will be used for the selection of applicants, admission procedures, pre-enrollment education, surveys such as follow-up surveys etc., post-enrollment student support (scholarships, tuition exemptions, health care, etc.), educational purposes such as academic guidance, tuition collection, etc., and surveys and research (improvement of entrance examinations, survey and analysis of applicant trends, etc. For enrolled students, this includes analysis along with personal information after enrollment.).

3) Work related to admissions and educational affairs may be performed by contractors entrusted by Tohoku University (hereinafter referred to as "contractors"). When outsourcing work, in case all or part of the personal information are provided to the contractors, we will take necessary measures to ensure that personal information is handled appropriately in accordance with the relevant regulations of Tohoku University, such as "Regulations on Protection of Personal Information at National University Corporation Tohoku University".

4) Applicants to the Tohoku University Graduate School of Medicine are understood to be in agreement with the content of the statement above.

Applicants requiring special care during the examination procedures and subsequent schooling should request advice in advance by contacting the Graduate Academic Affairs Section, Graduate School of Medicine. Please submit your "special care" requirement with

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prescribed form to Academic Affairs Section during the “Pre-Screening” period described on the front cover of this application guidelines.

- (3) Those who apply for the PhD Program Examination for Admission for Overseas Resident Major of DISABILITY SCIENCES HEALTH SCIENCES for the academic year 2027 April cannot apply for the PhD Program Major of DISABILITY SCIENCES HEALTH SCIENCES for the academic year 2026 Oct and the PhD Program Major of DISABILITY SCIENCES HEALTH SCIENCES for the academic year 2027 April to be held on the same day.
